



Goals & Focus

Goals:

Create a coordinated care network connecting students with the resources necessary to succeed.

Use technological and analytical tools to identify struggling students and eliminate the barriers to their timely degree completion.

Track student performance and deliver timely and appropriate interventions; share data insights and predictive analytics.

Focus on two metrics where performance is significantly below the targets:

4-Year FTIC Graduation Rate: 65%. Current performance: 54.2%

3-Year Transfer Graduation Rate: 70%. Current performance: 50.9%


